Zoning and Siblings

Many New Zealand schools operate a ZONE that binds us to very strict entry rules. This is to prevent overcrowding and ensures all schools are attended by the people in their local area, first and foremost.

If your child has entered Witherlea under the ballot system meaning they are OUT of ZONE or you have shifted house after one of your children has started school IN ZONE but are now OUT of ZONE then we want to make you aware that siblings do not get automatic entry to Witherlea.

Siblings, like all other students, would have to come in under the ballot system. This is advertised in the local paper in October each year and only operates if there is space the following year (this will be 2022).

So, if you come to the office to enrol your child and your address is OUT of the ZONE then you will not be able to enter until a ballot has been decided upon. There is more information on our website regarding the priorities of entry which sibling is number two.

COVID UPDATE

It wouldn't be a year without COVID popping up and the changing of Alert Levels. It is very important that if we were requested to go into LOCKDOWN again that we were able to provide learning that suited students of different ages and stages. Part of this is knowing 'how many devices' would be required in homes. We ONLY provide Chromebooks and this is to our Year 3-6 students. We have a simple '3 question' Google Form to complete at the start of every year so we are ready to deploy if needed.

Every classroom has Seesaw, so ensuring you are signed up for this is at the start of every year is important. All Year 3-6 students have Google Accounts, however, this only starts at Year 3 so these students 'begin to learn the basics' through till the end of Year 4.

Our Year 5-6 students should be able to manage themselves digitally and access their learning via Google Classroom, their own drives and can use Google Meet.

We will have a website for parents to access ideas/learning experiences at home otherwise if children or families are having to self isolate for extended periods hard packs can be created to support learning at home.

2021 Assemblies: Alert Level 1

The assembly time for 2021 has changed this year to 2:15pm and will go through to 2:45pm. We will try and hold these assemblies outdoors for Term 1 and they are designed to introduce our four teams; Kauri, Kowhai, Punga and the Ferns. These assemblies are held fortnightly and are on even weeks starting Week 4, this week being the first.

We give out our 'Welcome to School' and 'Early Words' certificates at our Flag Raising on a Monday at 8:55am - all are welcome at Alert Level 1.

Parent Teacher Interviews

These are a little different this year and came out of some great thinking and discussion time with all the teachers during our 'Learning Days' at the start of the year.

We have decided to have our Parent Teacher Interviews before creating our Initial Reports: Year 2-6 students. We are going to spend part of the meeting looking at where each child is and then creating goals for learning together.

We know our parents have important aspirations and information regarding their own children so having you as part of the process in reporting is a natural next step, for us as we join forces and support All our learners to reach their potential.

So, we ask all parents and caregivers to attend these meetings. We also ask that families that may be split only book ONE meeting and come together during that time, for their child. We only allocate one meeting per child so this is important and ensures all children in each class get a fair deal
